School uniform reminder....

If you are planning to buy uniform ready for next year please remember that the Tesco website gets very busy at this time of the year. Orders are likely to take approximately 3 weeks at the moment and this time scale will only get longer as hundreds of schools are placing orders ready for September.

While thinking about uniform, here is a list of our uniform choices:

- Navy blue cardigans, jumpers or sweatshirts (plain or with the school logo – no hoods)
- Black or grey trousers, shorts, skirts, pinafore dresses (not leggings or joggers unless for outdoor PE)
- White or pale blue shirts
- Blue and white striped or checked summer dresses.

PE kit.

- White teeshirt (plain or school logo)
- Navy shorts for indoor PE
- Navy joggers or leggings (plain – no logo)
- Trainers suitable for outdoor PE

All of these items, and many more, such as jackets and book bags are available from the Tesco website.

Everyone has been asked to fill out menu choices for the whole term, either through ParentMail or on paper. Booking forms for both clubs are available on ParentMail. You can book either club, for any day of the week, for the whole term. When making a booking, please take into account that bookings should be made 48 hours in advance to allow time for the bookings to be processed. Breakfast club is charged at £4.50 a day and After school club is charged at £10.00 per day and will be invoiced upon receipt of the booking forms.
