Go on a Spring walk to see what plants and flowers you can find growing. Take some photos and put them on Tapestry or draw a picture.




Find out the most popular type of flower in your family

Visit the library to find a book about flowers, seeds or plants. Perhaps you could borrow the book and bring it in for us to read.




Sunflower is a very long word for a very tall plant. It is made up of two shorter words. Can you think of any more words that are made up of two shorter words? Try and write them in a list.
