



## Home Learning

Maths	<p>Complete a times table rock star activity every day!</p> 	<p>We are focussing on multiplication and division in maths. Can you write Ancient Egyptian multiplication or division problems?</p> 	<p>Go to the supermarket with an adult. Write down the prices of 5 items. Work out the total price for the items. <b>Can you create 3 word problems using the items and their prices? (5 extra dojo points)</b></p> 	<p>I am thinking of a number. After I add 5,241 and subtract 352, my number is 9,485. What is my original number? What facts can you tell me about this number? (Think of factors/multiples/prime numbers)</p> 
Others	<p>Discuss with your family the differences between Egyptian life and your life. Can you write a list of the biggest differences?</p> 	<p>Create a poster to show an aspect of learning we have done this term. It can be from any subject, for example, life cycles in Science.</p> 	<p>Can you design a flag for Ancient Egypt? Think about the colours used in Egyptian paintings and the meanings behind them.</p> 	<p>Can you create your own Egyptian God? What are they the god of? What animal head would they have? What offerings would please them?</p>
