

### English

**Writing-** Using the story Christmas Football and the topic Fallen Fields , we will be writing a narratives, a persuasive texts, balanced arguments (Is war a good positive thing) and recounts.

**GPS-** Children will learn a range of different word class based on their function in a sentence. We are also focussing on different cohesive devices. Children will are expected to confidently use a wide range of punctuation within their sentences and understand their purpose.

**Reading-**As a Year 6, we will be using I am David by Anne Holm as our guided reading and class text. Children are expected to read daily and record purposeful comments in their reading records.

### I.C.T.

In computing we will be recapping E-Safety with the children. We will also be learning about email:

- How to send and receive
- How to include attachments
- How to use cc and bcc

### R.E.

This term we will be looking at how different religions celebrate and then also writing our own versions of the Christmas Nativity story.


### Music
