

## Home Learning Tasks (20<sup>th</sup> April – 24<sup>th</sup> April)

### Year 1

#### Daily Phonics Tasks

Parents/carers: Please watch the video link below to listen to the pure sounds that children are taught in school. This will enable you to hear the pronunciation of sounds and ensure that your child is saying them correctly.

This term we will focus on one Phase 5 sound each week, (these are ones we have done before, but want to make sure we are **amazing** at).

#### **Monday**

lay, stray, spray, crayon, sclay, glay, deflay

- Say the sound 'ay' out loud.
- Teach your grown up how to say the sound.
- Try reading the words (real and alien) to your grown up.
- Copy each word out twice on separate small pieces of paper and play 'pairs' with your grown up (words face down, spread out on carpet and take turns to turn over two to try to find matching pairs).

#### **Tuesday**

- Read yesterday's 'ay' words again.
- Play 'Buried Treasure' on Phonics Play focusing on 'ay' words.

#### **Wednesday**

- Read this weeks 'ay' words again.
- Ask your adult to read the real words out to you for you to write.
- Can you think of any other words with this 'ay' grapheme?
- Play 'Picnic on Pluto' with 'ay' words on Phonics Play.

#### **Thursday**

- Read this weeks 'ay' words again.
- Ask your grown-up to read the sentences below for you to have a go at writing:

Can a crayon spray paint?

Can a stray cat play?

Do not delay unless you want to stay all day.

#### **Friday (Tricky Words)**

oh, their, people

- Read the tricky words above and practise writing them 3 times each.
- Ask your adult to call out the words for you to write.

- Get your adult to write these sentences for you to read:

Some people play loud sounds on horns.

Oh! I found a crayon.

Do people play with their sprouts?

### Daily Reading Tasks

Read a book to your grown up every day. If you have already finished the books sent home with you, create a free account with [www.oxfordowl.co.uk](http://www.oxfordowl.co.uk) and read one of their fantastic books.

Listen to your grown up read a story to you, take some time to talk about words you have not heard before.

### Daily Literacy Tasks

This week we are going to be looking at the traditional tale, 'Little Red Riding Hood'.

#### Monday

- Have a go at acting out the story at home, thinking about which order events happen.

#### Tuesday

- Re watch Little Red Riding Hood.
- Draw a story map showing the sequencing of events in Little Red Riding Hood.

#### Wednesday

- Re watch Little Red Riding Hood.
- Can you add some sentences to your story map, explaining what is happening in each picture?

#### Thursday

- Choose your favourite character from the story and draw a picture of them.
- Using adjectives, write some simple labels describing the character, e.g. 'sharp teeth', 'red cloak', 'pointy ears'.

#### Friday

- Using your simple labels from yesterday, write sentences describing your character.
- Challenge yourself to use the words 'and' and 'because' to join your ideas.
- Remember capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.
- Can you read your sentences to a grown up, checking they make sense?

### Daily Maths Tasks

This week we are focusing on shapes (geometry).

#### Monday
