

Reminders:

PSED

Physical Development

- This term the children will have lots of opportunities to challenge themselves using the outside equipment.
- We will be working on using the correct pencil grip and learning how to form some letters.
- We will be encouraging children to independently follow basic hygiene routines such as washing hands before eating.
- Adults will be supporting the children's snack times this term to encourage children to eat healthy snacks and discuss why healthy food is important.

Focus: Getting to know me

Expressive Arts and Design

- This term the children will be encouraged to explore different media and resources.
- We will be learning about colour mixing using paint and pastels.

Literacy

- We will be sharing lots of stories and discussing the characters and what is happening in the plot.
- In phonics we will learn to read and write the letters of the alphabet. We will learn to say letter sounds not letter names.
- Every day, in our phonics sessions we will practice orally blending and segmenting.

Maths

- This term we will be exploring numbers up to 5 in great depth; working on ordering, recognising how numbers can be represented, ways to make numbers and recognising amounts without needing to count.
- We will be looking at numbers which are important to us such as birthdays, door numbers and ages.
- We will explore patterns and shapes

Understanding of the World

- We will be looking at the changes in the environment as the season changes to Autumn.
- The classroom interactive whiteboards will be used during free flow times for playing games which support our learning in maths and phonics this term.
- We will be encouraging the children to tell us about their families and special family times when sharing their family photos.
