Maths at Stephen Freeman engages and empowers children to be their best and take control of their learning.

Our children are encouraged to make connections, spot patterns and apply their knowledge to new challenges. They work on each strand on the Maths National Curriculum: fluency, reasoning and problem solving, in order to become independent, confident learners. We deepen children's understanding with contextual problems to ensure they can solve them when needed in the wider world.

At Stephen Freeman, we have high expectations for each child to reach their potential, with high levels of support from staff to help this happen. Pictorial and concrete representations are always used as the foundation for learning throughout the key stages to scaffold new concepts.

We use a mastery approach to ensure all children at working through the curriculum at the same pace, but we tailor this to their own level of attainment so they can succeed.
