

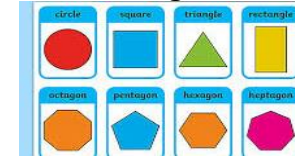
Practice writing the letters of the alphabet. Make sure you write the letters correctly.

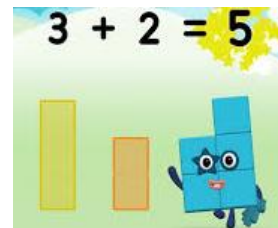
Choose 5 items from your house. Which is the heaviest? How do you know? Can you arrange the items from the heaviest to the lightest?
