

English

Writing- We will be writing the Christmas Truce, using a video to help us. We will also write a letter as if we were an evacuee writing back to our parents. We will finish the term writing war poems.

GPS- Children will learn about adjectives, adverbs/adverbials, metaphors and similes to use descriptively within our work.

Reading- I Am David will be our guided reading text. We will explore the story's themes and main content as well as think carefully about vocabulary and the author's choices when writing.

Computing

In computing we will be learning to present information in various ways using computers. The children will create presentations about themselves, word processing the information first. They will also input data into spreadsheets.

R.E.

This term we will be looking at beliefs and practices in the Christian faith. Children will learn about the Christian Christmas story and look at how this compares to other religions and cultures.

Music

In music we will be following the Charanga Scheme. We will learn some popular songs from wartime, as well as learning Christmas carols.

Term 2 - Year 6 World Wars



Foreign languages French

This term we will be recap French taught last year, such as numbers, colours, days of the week, as well as basic conversation.

We will start to move onto writing our own conversation in French and practising with our partners.

Art & DT

This term children will create silhouette pictures of soldiers on a battlefield, as well as creating our own propaganda poster to persuade people to follow wartime rules!

Science

In Science, we will be learning about Electricity. We will learn how electricity is generated and identify appliances that use electricity. We will also learn about conductors and insulators and different types of circuits including switches.

Topic World Wars

We will look at the causes of both World Wars, looking at factors such as the assassination of Franz Ferdinand and the Treaty of Versailles' restrictions.

We will also learn and about life on the front line as well as life in wartime Britain.

PSHE

As a school we are following the Jigsaw Scheme. Our focus this term is 'Celebrating Difference'. We will be looking at other cultures and explore how their lives are the same and different than our own, as well as celebrating the diversity in who we are as a group.

We will be securing number facts such as times tables throughout the term to ensure children are fluent.

We will also continuing with multiplication and division, using lots of problem solving, reasoning and number work to secure our knowledge. Afterwards, we will look at operations with fractions and position and direction.
