

## English

**Writing-** We will be writing a 'Change of Heart' story about a character who changes their mind about something. We will also be writing an information text about the heart, the blood and the circulatory system. Lastly we will be writing a balanced argument.

**GPS-** Children will learn about relative clauses, dashes, brackets, modal verbs and correct speech punctuation.

**Reading** – Pig Heart Boy will be our guided reading text. We will explore the story's themes and main content as well as think carefully about vocabulary and the author's choices.

## Computing

In computing we will be learning to create a multi-level game using Scratch. Children will need to program algorithms to make sequences of events happen when they play. They will also need to debug the game to fix any errors.

## R.E.

This term we will be looking at beliefs and practices in the Judaist and Buddhist faiths.

Children will learn about the concept of eternal life and the impact on the lives of believers. They will also explore whether anything can truly last forever.

## Music

In music we will be learning basic notes on a recorder along with simple tunes, as well as learning how to read musical notes on a scale.

## Term 3 - Year 6 The Circulatory System



## Foreign languages French

This term we will be recap French taught last year, such as days of the weeks/months of the year.

They will also be learning about French names for food and writing their own French menu. The children will also learn about the terms for family life.

## Art & DT

This term children will create pieces in the Pop Art style, recreating works of Andy Warhol and Roy Lichtenstein. They will eventually create their own Pop Art piece.

## Science

In Science, we will be learning about the Human Body.

This will focus on the Circulatory System but will also include the skeleton, the function of organs in our body and the impact of smoking and alcohol.

## Topic Benin

We will learn about the history of the ancient Kingdom of Benin, now in modern Nigeria. Children will learn about the history of Africa and challenge their preconceptions about life of the continent.

They will learn about Benin's religion, art, and past.

## PSHE

As a school we are following the Jigsaw Scheme. Our focus this term is 'Dreams and Goals'. We will be looking at how we can achieve our dreams and what steps we need to take to get there. We will also consider how to be the best version of ourselves.
