English	Make a list of the characters you can remember from Beowulf – you may need to wait until we are halfway into the book!	Research the original story of Beowulf. Where did it originate? How many different forms or languages can you find it in?	Create a Wanted poster for Grendel listing why he must be stopped. What are his crimes? What must his punishment be?	Can you write your own version of Beowulf? Make sure you change the main character and the setting.
Maths	Write and solve 5 long multiplication questions.	Do TTRS everyday for TWO weeks. See how much you can improve your fastest time per question.	Get a grown up to write you 5 word problems which use any of the following operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.	Create board game with the Evolution or Adaptation theme that covers many different Year 6 maths topics. You will be able to play it with friends of your choice.
Other	Draw a picture of what you imagine Grendel looking like. How disgusting and wicked can you make it look?	Research examples of animal which have evolved over time. Why did they need to adapt? What benefit did evolution have?	Research some Salvador Dali pieces. Write a paragraph about which is your favourite & why, then do a quick sketch of it.	Can you make a salt dough fossil of your own at home? There are lots of easy guides to be followed online!
