- This term the children will learn what it means to be part of the Rainbows Nursery community.

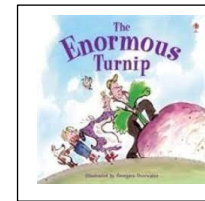
Communication and Language

Physical Development

- Our lovely outside area is perfect to practise movement, balances, different ways of moving and ball skills. We will also encourage the children to use the bikes and other equipment outside.
- Some of the songs we sing will practise the movement of rising from floor to standing, Dingle dangle scarecrow is one of the songs perfect for this.

Literacy

- We will be sharing lots of stories and talking about our favourite books.
- The children will be looking at print in the environment and thinking about what print can be used for.
- The children will be learning about the important things to include when they draw a self portrait, they will each draw a portrait to be displayed in the classroom and will start to think about what their name looks like.

Maths

- This term we will learn lots of number songs and use our finger to help with them.
- We will think about numbers up to 5, what 5 looks like (not just the written number but 5 objects, jumps, bangs etc).
- We will look at the patterns we can see around us likes stripes and spots.
- During free flow the adults will be modelling, and encouraging the children to use maths words like more, less, the same, bigger, and smaller.

Understanding of the World

- We will be exploring vegetables including a turnip like the one in our story.
- The children will have chance to explore recipe books and follow a recipe to make turnip soup.
- We will be looking at materials and objects and thinking about how they are the same and different.

Expressive Arts and Design

- The children will have chance to explore the role play resources in the classroom and use them in their play.
- We will work on matching and identifying the sounds of instruments.
- The children will have chance to listen to different types of music and decide which they like.
