Create some art inspired by 'The Great Fire of London'.



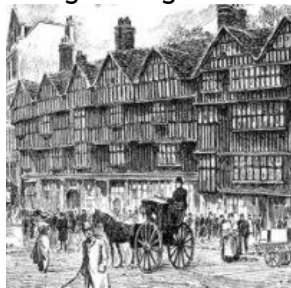
An idea of your own!
