

## English

**Writing-** We will be writing a diary entry about being a sailor on one of Francis Drake's ships and a newspaper report on Henry VIII.

**GPS-** Children will learn more about the structure of sentences and using the skills learnt within their writing.

## Computing

This term, we completing more music appreciation work and learning the song Dancing in the Street.

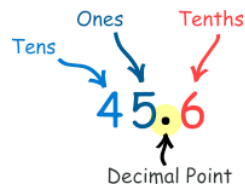
## Term 5 - Year 5 'The Tudors'



## Maths

We will continue to learn about fractions, decimals and percentages – we will learn how they compare to each other.
