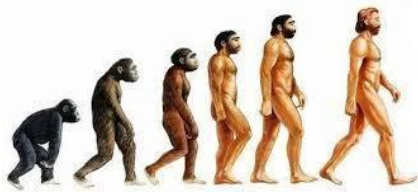





Topic: Evolution

Choose 3 animals and explain how they are adapted to their habitats.	Find two examples of fossils and draw them.	Choose 4 different birds. Choose at least 4 things you would change about humans. Create a poster explaining what you would change and how this would help humans to survive in modern times.
Draw a diagram showing how an animal has evolved over time.	Make a poster about a species of dinosaur. Explain how it was adapted to its habitat. 	Draw a picture of a DNA molecule and explain how DNA affects humans.	Create a poster for children explaining what evolution is.
