

YEAR 4 –TERM 2 Potions and Magic!

English

This term we will be learning the skills to write poetry (shape and rhyming) and building on the skills we learnt last term by writing a narrative.

We will be learning and performing the 'Song of the Witches' from Macbeth. The children will then create their own rhyming poem.

"Double, double toil and trouble; Fire burn and cauldron bubble!"

We will finish the term by writing a narrative based on an alternate version of Snow White from the Wicked Queen's perspective.

Maths

This term in Maths, we will be spending a significant amount of the term learning about multiplication and division. In the second half of the term, we will be introducing length, perimeter and area.

We are will be focusing on our times table this year.
This term we will be focused on learning the 6 and 12 times table.

Science

States of Matter

In this unit we will be learning abou solids, liquids and gases. We will learn how to identify each state of matter and each of their properties.

We will learn how states of matter can change through melting, freezing, evaporation and condensation; linking their new learning to the water cycle. During experiments, we will be observing how quickly a solid melts and what affects the rate that it melts.
