

English

Through our topic, the children will be completing two tasks this term including writing a persuasive letter to Willy Wonka and creating their own room in the chocolate factory. Children will learn the key features and layout of a letter and be able to apply this in their learning. They will also be learning about nouns, adjectives, verbs and adverbs to be included in their writing.

Guided reading:

This term we will be studying the book **Charlie and the Chocolate Factory** by Roald Dahl.

Geography

We will be looking at land use, using maps. The children will be:

- Sketching simple maps.
- Learning about the compass.
- Learning about the different symbols on a map.

Art & DT

This term, children will be looking, comparing, designing, creating and evaluating their own chocolate bar packaging.

Science – Light

Children will continue to learn about light; this will include studying:

- Recognising the difference between light and dark.
- To understand that light is reflected from surfaces.
- To recognise that light from the sun can be dangerous.
- To understand how shadows are formed.
- To find patterns in the way the size of a shadow changes.
