Create some art inspired by The Great Fire of London.



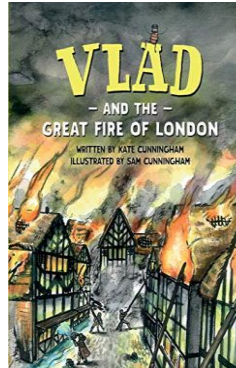
The Great Fire of London started in a bakery. Pretend that you are baker and bake some bread at home.
