

YEAR 4 –TERM 5

Gods and Mortals

English

In English this term we will be designing and creating a product for children to sell in Enterprise Week! We will be writing a persuasive letter to sell their products. We will also write a Newspaper report highlighting the success of Enterprise Week.

We will be focusing on imperative verbs, conjunctions, and noun phrases and descriptive language.

Maths

In Maths, we will be focusing on decimals, money and time. We will be making a whole with tenths and hundredths and rounding decimals. We will also convert and compare money amounts. In addition, we will be looking at telling and converting time.

This term, we will be focusing on the speed in which children can recall their times table facts up to 12 x 12.

Science

This term we will be learning about a variety of living things and organisms. We will also be learning about their habitats.

Computing

In Computing, we will be using Scratch to loop shapes, designing, creating and modifying a game.

History

This term we will be learning about the Ancient Greece. Specifically, we will be focusing on life in Ancient Greece, myths and the Trojan War.
