Perform dances using simple movement patterns.

Numeracy - counting within 100

Building on the counting skills learned in Reception, children will now:

- Count forwards and backwards within 100, starting from any number.
- Explore and understand how numbers are made up (the composition of numbers) from 20 up to 100.

Science - observe and explore how the seasons change across the year.

- Notice changes in the weather throughout the year.
- Describe how the length of the day changes in different seasons.
- Observe the effect of seasonal changes on plants, animals, and the environment.
- Record and talk about what they see, using simple equipment to help them.

Art & DT - Paint mixing and blending

Plan

Children will explore at least two different compositions and choose one to develop.

Create

Learn about the colour wheel and how colours can be blended.

Experiment with space, shape, and creating silhouettes.

Use these skills to make their own piece of art.

Evaluate

Take part in a class discussion about what went well and what was tricky. A photo of the finished artwork will be glued into each child's Art Sketch Book.

Geography- Me and My School

This term, children will be exploring their local environment, learning about geography, and developing early map skills. They will:

- Talk about their school and the different areas within it .
- Learn to describe features of their local environment.
- Begin to use simple maps, plans, and symbols.
- Explore how maps help us find and describe places.
- Start to use geographical language (e.g. near, far, left, right, next to).
