Listen to your adult read you a story. Talk to your adult about what you can see in the pictures and what you liked (or disliked) about the story.

Spot different groups of objects. Can you spot groups of 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5? It could be anything you see out and about or at home: leaves, birds, cups or baked beans!
